VICTORIA GOLD/NND CBA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE

AS PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE COOPERATION AND BENEFITS AGREEMENT

(CBA) signed between Victoria Gold and the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun (FNNND) in October 2011, a scholarship program was mutually established to help support FNNND citizens attending their post-secondary studies.

The scholarship program funding is applicable for full-time university, college or trades and technical courses and may be used for tuition, school supplies and equipment, rent, food, childcare and/or transportation costs.

The application deadline for the Fall 2021 semester is August 22, 2021 and scholarships will be awarded on September 3.

According to FNNND citizen and 2019 scholarship recipient Cathy Rear, now a Health Care Assistant, "the Victoria Gold-NND CBA Scholarship helped me focus on my studies by easing the financial burden of being a student. I appreciate both Victoria Gold and the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun for their support to FNNND citizens like me who are pursuing their post-secondary education."

Viktoria Skaper, another scholarship recipient and graduate of Simon Fraser University says, "attending post-secondary studies outside the territory is costly so I depended on, and am so appreciative of the Victoria Gold-NND Scholarship funding to help support me during the school year. I was extremely grateful each time my scholarship application was accepted and how the support helped me to offset the stresses of adult life during my years of study."

Since the program's creation and establishment, 120 scholarships have been awarded to the First Nation's citizens pursuing their post-secondary studies for a total disbursement totalling well over \$100,000.
