TWICE A YEAR, THE VICTORIA GOLD TEAM PUTS OUT A CALL TO FIRST NATION OF NA-CHO NYAK DUN (NND) CITIZENS PURSUING POST-SECONDARY STUDIES TO APPLY FOR THE VICTORIA GOLD NND/CBA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

Since the scholarship program's establishment in 2012, when Victoria worked with the NND Education Department to develop the criterion and application requirements, 111 scholarships have been awarded to NND citizens for a total disbursement over \$100,000.

Former CBA Scholarship recipient Viktoria Skaper pursued her Bachelors of Arts and Social Sciences in English, with a Psychology minor, from Simon Fraser University.

The Eagle Gold Mine, now in production, is part of Victoria's 100-per cent-owned Dublin Gulch Property located approximately 375 kilometres north of Whitehorse and 85 kilometres north, northeast of the Village of Mayo within the traditional territory of the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun. The property is accessible by road year-round and is connected to Yukon Energy Corp's electrical grid. The mine will be a significant contributor to Yukon employing 350 to 400 people.
