

### VICTORIA GOLD'S EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS AT THE EAGLE GOLD MINE

Victoria Gold is committed to high Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) standards and best practices throughout the Company's operations, which includes minimizing its greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) at the Eagle Gold Mine.

One example includes working with Yukon company Kal Tire to retread the mine site's CAT 903D loader tires.

"In 2023, by retreading existing tires versus purchasing new ones, this initiative and partnership with Kal saved 69,284 kg of carbon and avoided the use of 1,545 litres of oil," says Victoria Gold President & CEO John McConnell.

The scope of retread and repair provided environmental benefits equivalent to enabling an average family to travel over 270,000 km by car or provide a CAT 777F haul truck with enough fuel to operate for a year.




"Moving forward, we will continue to seek environmentally and fiscally sustainable ways to retread more tires to further reduce the Company's carbon footprint at the Eagle Gold Mine," adds McConnell.

Victoria Gold is also committed to a safe, productive and healthy work environment for its employees and contractors through reduced emissions.

For example, the Company has developed an Idling Policy to help protect air quality by reducing the environmental impact and health risks associated with engine idling; which is permitted for site equipment and vehicles in use when the ambient air temperature at the mine site is -20C or colder. Victoria Gold implemented a software program to monitor the site's production fleets and the non-essential idling equipment can be identified and turned off.

In 2024, Victoria Gold is examining the implementation of vehicle block warmers to further reduce idling hours during the coldest months of the year.
